It is my pleasure on behalf of the Fast-Track Projects Advisory Group (**Advisory Group**) to provide this independent report (**Report**) to Ministers, recommending infrastructure and development projects that we consider suitable for listing in Schedule 2 of the Fast-track Approvals Bill (version dated 12 April 2024) (**Bill**).

Working to the Terms of Reference (**TOR**) we assessed 384 project applications. This was a significant exercise requiring consideration of tens of thousands of pages, completed within a relatively short three-month timeframe. The applications were diverse in nature and scale, submitted by a broad range of private, public, and Māori interests, covering all regions.

I would like to thank my fellow Advisory Group members for their professionalism, commitment and sharing their significant skills and expertise, which was vital for completion of this Report in a timely manner. Thank you also to the central Government officials who assisted the Advisory Group with its mahi, in particular those from the Ministry for the Environment Manatū Mō Te Taio and the Ministry of Business, Innovation & Employment Hīkina Whakatutuki.

The Advisory Group wishes Ministers well in deciding which projects they consider are suitable for listing in Schedule 2 of the Bill. We are able to talk to our Report if required.

## **Executive Summary**

The Ministry for the Environment Manatū Mō Te Taio (**MFE**) received 392 applications to be listed in Schedule 2 of the Bill by the closing date, nearly double the number anticipated before applications opened. Of the 392 applications, 8 withdrew and 384 were assessed by the Advisory Group.

There is clearly significant interest in a Fast-track decision making process for infrastructure and development projects across all regions and from a broad range of private, public, and Māori interests.

Given the volume, diverse nature, and varying scale of proposed projects we categorised applications into five sectors – Aquaculture and Farming, Housing and Land Development, Infrastructure, Mining and Quarrying, and Renewable Electricity.

Of the 384 applications the Advisory Group consider that 342 can provide significant regional or national benefits and accordingly we recommend that:

- 199 projects be listed in Schedule 2 Part A (2A);
- 143 projects be listed in Schedule 2 Part B (2B); and
- 42 projects not be listed.

We have recommended priority rankings for all 2A and 2B projects and trust this is useful in assisting Ministers making decisions on which projects are ultimately listed, and if so where.

As requested, we considered, and make commentary in this report on risks related to projects, so far as that was possible within the time available. This includes commentary on risk related to Expert Panel capacity to assess a large number of projects with complex issues including environmental effects, and Treaty Settlement obligations and recognised customary rights.

If a majority of the projects we recommend are included in the Bill it will clearly enable a material uplift in infrastructure and development projects delivering significant regional or national benefits.

### 1. Background

#### The Advisory Group

The Advisory Group were appointed by Cabinet in April 2024 and was made up of six independent members who represent a range of expertise and experience on relevant matters including infrastructure, economic development, environment, conservation, Treaty of Waitangi, and local government. The Advisory Group members were David Tapsell (Chair), Rosie Mercer, Murray Parrish, Vaughan Wilkinson, David Hunt, and Mark Davey.

#### **Dealing with Conflicts of Interest**

The Advisory Group declared any initial actual or perceived conflicts of interest as part of their appointment process through the Appointments and Honours Cabinet Committee.

In addition, a Conflicts of Interest register was established which was used to track and manage any further actual or perceived conflicts identified by Advisory Group members once applicant details were provided by officials, but before applications were assessed.

The sector experience of all Advisory Group members meant that they either knew and/or had historically been associated in some advisory capacity with a number of applicants and/or other parties mentioned in the applications.

Perceived conflicts once disclosed to all other Advisory Group members did not disqualify Advisory Group members with a perceived conflict from receiving applications, participating in discussions, and voting.

Where the Conflict of Interest was of the nature of an actual direct or indirect financial or pecuniary gain, or direct or indirect competition with any application, then that Advisory Group member did not receive that application, participate in any discussions on it, nor vote.

#### **Independence from Ministers**

Ministers were kept totally isolated from the decisions and workings of the Advisory Group. This was to ensure that there was no influence from Ministers and to allow the Advisory Group to act independently when making recommendations and completing this report.

Basic information was shared by officials with Ministers, such as the number of applications that were received when the application portal closed and to clarify the intention of specific parts of the Bill.

### 2. Advisory Group Assessment Process

#### **Project Applications**

The listed projects application portal was open on the MFE website from 3 April 2024 to 3 May 2024. Applicants were required to provide information equivalent to that in clause 14(3) of the Bill. A total of 392 applications were received, 8 withdrew, and 384 were assessed.

#### **Central Government Agency Role**

In accordance with the TOR, central government agency officials (MFE) processed applications, undertook initial checks (including eligibility and ineligibility), and summarised any consultation undertaken by applicants or central government. They also summarised any relevant Treaty settlement provisions and the impacts of a project on Māori development and local Post Settlement Governance Entity settlement priorities.

The relevant information from this exercise was recorded in official's summary papers (Official's Summary Papers).

Central government agency officials loaded completed Officials Summary Papers progressively on the Advisory Group portal for their consideration in advance of each Advisory Group meeting. This was a significant exercise requiring the review and consideration of tens of thousands of pages of material across 384 applications.

#### **Advisory Group Meetings**

The Advisory Group held 12 in person meetings to consider, discuss, assess, and make recommendations on all applications. All Advisory Group members were well prepared for meetings which required, among other things, a significant time commitment to read all the necessary paperwork in advance of all meetings. This was essential and ensured an efficient use of the time at meetings to assess such a large number of applications.

Officials attended all meetings although the Advisory Group broke into Advisory Group only time on limited occasions. The Advisory Group also invited and heard from a number of central Government agency sector specialists. The Advisory Group were not permitted to so did not seek comments or consult third parties.

The Advisory Group also held a number of Teams meetings as required in between in person meetings. No recommendations were made on applications at meetings held fully online.

The Advisory Group's assessment of all applications included consideration of the Official's Summary Paper, the TOR, and relevant sections of the Bill. For a number of applications, we sought further clarification from applicants in writing, and in most cases, we received written responses.

Exercising its collective judgement the Advisory Group assigned preliminary recommendations to each project as we progressively worked through the applications.

These preliminary recommendations were then re-considered once all applications had been assessed by us. This was important for our prioritisation exercise, to ensure consistency and to reach agreement on final recommendations.

## 3. Purpose and Primary Deliverable

The purpose of the Advisory Group was to independently assess and provide recommendations to Ministers regarding projects that the Advisory Group considered suitable for listing in Schedule 2 of the Bill.

The primary deliverable of the Advisory Group was to provide a report to Ministers by 2 August 2024 which recommended:

- projects they consider should be included in Part A or Part B of Schedule 2 of the Bill, with reasons why, and which projects should not be included in Schedule 2 of the Bill, and why; and
- the priority of projects both in terms of their worthiness of being listed as well as the order in which they should be referred to the Expert Panel.

#### **Sectors**

The Advisory Group had to assess a significant number of applications, diverse in both nature and scale, in a limited timeframe. To better facilitate a fair assessment of similar applications we categorised projects by sectors into Aquaculture and Farming, Housing and Land Development, Infrastructure, Mining and Quarrying and Renewable Electricity. Assessing applications in the context of these sector narratives was also important in our consideration of significant regional or national benefits.

The sector narratives are detailed in Section 5 of this report.

#### Significant Regional or National Benefits

The Bill only applies to projects that can deliver significant regional or national benefits. Accordingly, a fundamental exercise for the Advisory Group was to assess applications and for members to exercise their best judgement as to whether or not the projects promoted in those applications could deliver significant regional or national benefits.

Of the 384 applications the Advisory Group are of the view that 342 projects, assessed in the context of the sector narratives, could deliver significant regional or national benefits. In that regard we consider that those projects satisfy one or more of the sub-clauses in clause 17, while also being cognisant of the broad economic benefit ground in clause 17(3).

The Advisory Group recommend that 42 applications are not listed in the Bill. The majority of these could not in our view deliver significant regional or national benefits, while others were lacking material information or were ineligible for other reasons.

#### 2A or 2B

The Bill does not provide guidance on what differentiates the suitability/worthiness of a 2A listed project from a 2B listed project. The TOR provides some guidance on this. Interestingly, we note that the Bill provides guidance on deadlines for referred projects, but not 2A projects.

Overall, the Advisory Group consider that 2A listed projects must be supported by applications that have all material information included, which appear to be more "shovel ready" in a timely manner and based on our judgement, have a stronger chance of delivering the stated outcomes, than 2B listed projects.

For instance, although the Bill does not require an applicant to hold a legal interest in the land on which the proposed project will occur, the Advisory Group did not recommend projects for 2A unless they were satisfied (based on the application itself or answers to follow up questions to the applicant) that the applicant either held a legal interest in the land or had demonstrated that it could be obtained in a timely manner.

Of the 384 projects, 285 applied for 2A and 99 applied for 2B. The Advisory Group recommend that:

From the 285 that applied for Part A:

- 199 be listed in 2A;
- 55 be listed in 2B;
- 31 not be listed.

And from the 99 that applied for 2B:

- 88 be listed in 2B;
- 11 not be listed.

The TOR did not provide any guidance on the maximum number of projects for either 2A or 2B. We are cognisant of the fact that we have recommended a significant number of projects for both 2A and 2B and there may be Expert Panel capacity issues (see Risk section 4) especially for processing 2A projects. In that regard we note Ministers make final decisions on what projects are included in the Bill, and in what part – 2A or 2B.

The Advisory Group observed if a majority of the projects we recommend are ultimately included in the Bill, that would enable a material uplift in infrastructure and development projects delivering significant regional or national benefits.

#### **Prioritisation**

The TOR requires the Advisory Group to provide recommendations on the priority of projects both in terms of their worthiness of being listed, as well as the order in which they should be referred to an Expert Panel post-enactment.

Given the significant number of applications received, the due date for this Report, and the consequence of listing 2A projects in the Bill the Advisory Group afforded more attention in prioritising 2A projects than 2B projects.

Furthermore, we considered that the best approach was to allocate priority rankings 1 to 5 for all 2A projects within each sector (1 being afforded the highest priority) as opposed to prioritising all 2A projects 1 through to 199.

For 2B projects, we used the same ranking system, but we prioritised those projects as either High, Medium, or Low (High being the highest priority). This was due to our focus on 2A projects, this Report deadline, and our understanding of the ability of Ministers to prioritise 2B projects by referral post enactment.

#### 4. Risks

The TOR provides that the report should also include any risks related to projects that Ministers should consider. We have done this so far as that was possible within the time available and our TOR scope limitations.

#### **Applications with Prior History**

We received and assessed a number of applications for projects that have previously attracted some controversy in the public domain.

We also received and assessed a number of applications for projects which are seeking approval through the current system, and/or projects which have previously been declined based on a range of reasons including the assessed significance of related adverse environmental effects. Officials have a record of these applications which we understand will be included as part of official's briefings to Ministers.

The Bill does not prohibit applicants applying for Fast-track consenting while also pursuing processes through the current system, nor does it prohibit applicants from applying for Fast-tracking where consents have previously been declined.

#### **Reliance on Applicant Information**

The Advisory Groups assessment process included, among other things, consideration of the Officials Summary Paper for each project application. The Officials Summary Paper was based on the information provided by the applicants themselves. While applicants were required to certify that the information given in the applications was true and correct, this has not been independently verified. While that is not unusual at this stage of a process such as this, we wanted to note this.

#### **Commerciality and Completion**

Whether all or any of the projects we recommend in 2A and 2B proceed will be determined by a range of factors including, of course, commerciality and market forces. The Advisory Group were not tasked with undertaking any due diligence on project feasibility or commerciality.

#### **No Third-Party Comments or Consultation**

The TOR provided that the Advisory Group were not permitted to seek comments from any third parties nor consult on any application. Accordingly, our recommendations do not, and were not expected to, be informed by the views of any other parties who might otherwise be interested.

#### **Environmental Effects and Expert Panel**

Every project will have an effect on the environment. A number of applications relate to projects that have previously been declined based on a range of reasons including adverse environmental effects. Some of those projects have been controversial. The Bill does not prohibit any application based on prior decisions or controversy and we assessed all applications before us.

The Bill sets out the requirements of the Expert Panel when assessing consent applications. That applies to all 2A and 2B projects. This includes an assessment of the projects (activities) effects on the environment. In its written report to Ministers on all projects the Expert Panel must include a recommendation that Ministers either approve or decline all or part of a project and include any conditions that the Expert Panel considers should be imposed if the project is to be approved. That Expert Panel written report, recommendations, and any proposed conditions will also be informed by (among other things) the environmental effects of all projects as assessed by the Expert Panel.

The Advisory Group are not the Expert Panel. The Advisory Group did not (and were not expected to) undertake an assessment of environmental effects of any project. That is the role of the Expert Panel.

For completeness we note that the Bill provides Ministers with a specific discretion to decline an application for referral to the Expert Panel if the project may have significant adverse effects on the environment. Again, the Advisory Group did not, and were not expected to, provide recommendations to Ministers on environmental effects, including for 2A projects, to which the specific Ministerial referral discretion obviously does not apply.

#### **Treaty Settlement Obligations and Recognised Customary Rights**

Clause 6 of the Bill provides that all persons exercising functions, powers and duties under the Act must act in a manner that is consistent with obligations arising under existing Treaty settlements, and specific recognised customary rights. The Bill also imposes equivalency obligations.

Recognised customary rights are defined in the Bill. Treaty Settlement obligations while also defined broadly in the Bill are significant in number, diverse in both nature and complexity, and cover most of New Zealand. In the context of resource management those obligations were negotiated and agreed on the basis of the current system, not the Bill. They are recorded in Deeds of Settlement between the Crown and Iwi and/or statute, the result of over three decades of direct negotiation between the Crown and Iwi to settle historical Treaty of Waitangi grievances.



Inviting comments and consulting assists in the assessment of and response to potential risk based on the responses received. The Bill provides that the Expert Panel must invite comments for referral applications *and* listed projects. The Bill requires Ministers to invite comments and consult on referral applications only.



Although the Expert Panel are still required to invite comments on 2A listed projects (but not Ministers) we are mindful that Treaty Settlement obligations and recognised customary rights are the result of direct negotiation between the Crown and Iwi over many decades (not Expert Panels or officials). Where there is higher impact (and therefore potentially higher risk) for 2A projects, Ministers may consider it prudent to seek comment and consult.

#### **Number of Listed Projects and Expert Panel Capacity**

While it might be outside the scope of the Advisory Group, we also noted that for the Fast-track system to work in a timely manner it is vital that the requisite Expert Panels are in place and adequately resourced to deal with the higher-than-expected volume of Fast-track applications. It would be contrary to the purpose of the Bill if related systems and processes, including Expert Panels, are unable to move consents any faster than the normal consent process.

#### 5. Sector Narratives

The Advisory Group consider that 342 of the projects in the applications we assessed were consistent with the purpose of the Bill, that is, they could deliver infrastructure and development projects with significant regional or national benefits.

It was useful to assess applications on a sector basis. Among other things this enabled us to more accurately assess significance within that sector and recommend prioritisation of like for like projects.

#### **Aquaculture and Farming**

The Advisory Group assessed 29 Aquaculture and Farming projects. Of these, 28 were from the aquaculture sector and 1 was for farming. Because we recommend that the 1 farming project not be listed, this narrative only focuses on aquaculture.

The current regulatory framework and regional policy settings relevant to aquaculture have acted as either a barrier or significant impediment to development. In some regions aquaculture is permissively enabled, yet tightly constrained or largely prohibited in others. The Bill improves aquaculture public policy coherence by addressing the major factor that has been impeding the sector's growth and development which is the uncertainty, high cost and risk inherent in the current regulatory settings.

Facilitating the growth of aquaculture through expediting the consenting process should encourage and enable the sectors capacity to significantly improve its economic contribution to the regional and national economy. The global demand for seafood protein from a sustainable blue economy is only forecast to continue growing, in concert with the expansion of the middle classes in developing nations. The New Zealand aquaculture sector is well placed to contribute to that growing demand in a sustainable and climate friendly manner.

The outcomes of the Government Aquaculture Strategy are centered on inclusive, sustainable, and resilient production. The inclusiveness outcome recognises the need for partnering with Māori and communities to create employment opportunities, wellbeing, and prosperity. It is a direct acknowledgement of the increasingly important role that aquaculture can play in fostering improved regional economic prosperity in areas where there may be limited other opportunities for similar outcomes.

Aquaculture initiatives most frequently occur in rohe moana of lwi, and not surprisingly many lwi applied to fast-track their aquaculture projects. The Bill acknowledges the importance of inclusive engagement with lwi.

The Advisory Group's prioritisation of projects has considered those that either enable or partner with lwi to foster Māori economic development. Similarly, priority has also been accorded to projects that enhance sector resilience and sustainability, such as by affording improved security of mussel spat supply.

A number of projects we recommended as 2B involve lwi applicants where proposed aquaculture space is overlapped with other lwi applicants. The Advisory Group encourage

Ministers to engage with these lwi applicants to resolve these overlaps so that these development opportunities can be realised as soon as practicable.

#### **Housing and Land Development**

The Advisory Group assessed, 151 Housing and Land Development projects. This group comprises the largest number of applications assessed. To assist us, we further categorised applications into a number of sub-sectors, these included:

- Residential (118)
- Industrial and Commercial (22)
- Tourism (11)

Broadly, the location of the applications were generally centred on New Zealand's major urban centres and where growth pressures and demand are highest: Auckland, Hamilton, Tauranga, Wellington, Christchurch, and Queenstown.

The type of projects varied in scale and type, from large scale urban development projects delivering thousands of homes, through to smaller localised land development projects which included, tourism projects and site-specific industrial and commercial development activities.

The Advisory Group assessed applications under the sub-sectors above and the merit of the applications within their regional context. For example, papakāinga housing projects in Northland were not considered directly against large scale urban development housing projects in Auckland, as the characteristics of the projects and their local context are unique to each.

Alongside considering the merits of each application related to Housing and Land Development in a regional and national context against Clause 17(2) and relevant subclauses under 17(3), the Advisory Group also took account of relevant Government policies where they related to applications. These included Going for Housing Growth, the National Policy Statement: Urban Development (NPS:UD) and the New Zealand-Aotearoa Government Tourism Strategy.

In and around major urban centres, Government policy seeks to significantly increase the supply of land for urban development in areas of greatest demand and in doing so create more competitiveness within land markets. The outcome of this is to increase the supply and affordability of housing to create well-functioning urban environments.

The Bill offers the opportunity to enable genuinely new and innovative housing and land development projects which would contribute towards well-functioning urban environments. Based on our experience, some of the projects that would contribute to achieving this outcome, under the current system, would likely not gain approval as they are rarely contemplated by the existing planning frameworks.

The Housing and Land Development projects, particularly the residential applications, were at differing stages in their approvals process under the RMA. At one end of the spectrum there were projects that were already underway with some stages under construction and the applicants now seeking approvals under the Bill for later stages of the development.

Some projects had the required underlying zoning (e.g. a residential application in a residential zone) but had not yet sought resource consent. Some projects did not have the required underlying zoning but were in some form of future urban zone and/or identified in a plan or strategy (e.g. a Future Development Strategy under the National Policy Statement: Urban Development). Lastly, some Housing and Land development projects were not identified in a plan or strategy at all.

Based on the recommended projects for Schedule 2A & 2B, up to approximately 80,000 additional homes would be enabled, 75,000 of these in and around New Zealand's major urban growth centres and up to approximately 400 hectares of additional industrial activities.




Figure 1. Total 2A and 2B 'recommended projects' housing yield by region




Figure 2. Total 2A and 2B 'recommended projects' housing yields in high growth centres versus 5-year demand (Stats NZ 'High' 2023-2028)




Figure 3. Total 2A and 2B 'recommended projects' industrial quantum (ha) by region

There were 11 applications that the Advisory Group grouped as Tourism. Of the 11 applications assessed, 9 were recommended for listing. The majority of these applications were in the Queenstown Lakes area. The Tourism Strategy¹ seeks to lift the productivity of the sector by attracting more high-value tourists so that spend per tourist increases faster than the increase in tourist numbers. To assist in achieving this higher yield approach the Strategy identified the need for the industry to generate 'game-changing' new ideas and initiatives and deliver high-quality, authentic visitor experiences. This means the capacity of existing visitor destinations are grown and new visitor destinations are developed. In 2023 the estimated direct GDP contribution from Tourism to the New Zealand Economy was \$13.7B (3.7% of GDP) with an additional indirect contribution of \$8.8B (2.5% of GDP)². It should be noted that Tourism-related activities are generally high employment generators. One project alone estimates it would add \$350M/annum in direct economic benefit to the region including, 450 new jobs, supporting 2,500 jobs directly and indirectly in the region.




Figure 4. Number of Tourism 'recommended projects' (2A & 2B) by region

The Advisory Group prioritised projects that it considered would add genuinely new development supply and activities to the market ahead of those projects which already had the necessary "live" zone, resource consents, and in some instances already had stages of development underway. Accordingly, as per Clause 17(2)(b) of the Bill, for some applications, we considered that the Bill process would possibly be no timelier than if a Resource Consent was lodged.

We ranked projects based on the following factors:

1. the size and scale of the impact that the project could have on the supply of land and competitiveness in urban land markets;

- 2. whether or not the project was introducing new activity to the market;
- 3. the ability to address acute housing need in certain parts of the country;
- 4. the ability to enable more employment and innovative businesses near to major populations; and
- 5. the ability for New Zealand to increase its tourism earnings through new "destination" attractions.

It is important to note that the costs and time delays of RMA processes were often cited by applicants. Some had given up pursuing private plan changes or resource consents, others were awaiting the outcome of plan change or consent process, some were under appeal to the Environment Court, or seeking ministerial "call-in".

#### Infrastructure

The Advisory Group assessed 93 applications which we assigned the sub-categories of Transport, Marine Infrastructure, Water Infrastructure, Public Service, Public Infrastructure and Energy Infrastructure.

Applications were received from private companies, local government bodies and Government agencies. The infrastructure sector projects, while set in their particular geographic footprint, often had attributes and outcomes that achieve a reach far beyond their particular footprint. The vast majority of the infrastructure sector projects were assessed to deliver significant regional, if not national benefits. The infrastructure sector has the highest percentage of projects given a priority rating of 1 by the Advisory Group, reflective of the well acknowledged infrastructure deficit we currently have in New Zealand.

The types of projects in the infrastructure sector are prevalently economic enablers, being transport, freight and supply chain links and essential public infrastructure for economic wellbeing to develop and thrive. The majority of the infrastructure sector projects were assessed to be critical to efficient connectivity and on that basis alone to deliver significant regional and national benefits.

There were stand-out applications of a national benefit scale that included the NZTA Roads of National Significance, major capital projects at Upper North Island ports, freight, and urban transport projects of significant priority in Auckland and a water security project of significant scale in the Hawkes Bay. A common theme across many of the projects was their contribution to supporting and further enabling growth across the value chain for export products in the primary sector and services in the tourism sector.

At a regional level there were a number of public infrastructure projects with wastewater and landfill projects being prevalent. A number of these projects were subject of either nearing or expired consents or have been going through a consent application process for extended periods of multiple years. On face-value these projects appear to be of a business-as-usual nature. Whether intervention is needed or not may require a deeper understanding of the particular resource constraint and capabilities of the applicants, and instead the Advisory Group has considered the issue at hand in some of these where there is currently significant risk to the environment if the projects do not proceed in some form in a timely manner.

The Advisory Group has considered project readiness and sought to understand whether local or central Government project funding has been committed to enable the project to proceed. While some local and central government funding plans for large infrastructure projects may lack flexibility the Advisory Group has been mindful of the potential unlocking of access to funding or financing that can come from a project progressing successfully through a consent process.

There were 6 applications from Health New Zealand for hospital redevelopments and one application from a private entity for building new hospital in Wanaka. The Health New Zealand projects were all applications for 2B, while the private entity project did not appear to be sufficiently advanced to warrant its 2A application. The Advisory Group considers the hospital redevelopments to be of high priority and while not on the 2A recommended list wishes to draw Ministers' attention to these applications.

#### Mining and Quarrying

The Advisory Group assessed 41 project applications for mining and quarrying developments. Applications fell broadly into 2 categories, higher value minerals and coal extraction for export and higher volume quarrying and construction sand processing supplying the local domestic market.

The significant annualised and total financial benefit of some of the mining projects was assessed sufficient by itself to justify a high priority ranking, in some instances constituting a measurable shift in regional and national GDP.

Mining project applicants described the fiscal benefit accruing from their respective projects in broad terms including royalties, annualised & export earnings and the tax receipts arising from high-value regional employment.

High-value and regional employment associated with mining and quarrying projects was a secondary and significant consideration in the Advisory Group ranking of these projects. Continuity and expansion of employment in regions such as the West Coast would be facilitated by export of mineral resources such as coking coal and mineral ore. Such projects offer other attributable values where their scale and value enhance the profitability and therefore retention of regional infrastructure including ports and rail.

Quarried and dredged construction materials (sand, gravel, and hard fill etc) are of comparatively low value when considered in isolation. A feature of the applications for quarrying and sand extraction projects was the contribution the products of such activity make to the delivery of other regionally and nationally significant activities.

Some natural hazards and climate-related mitigation is dependent on the availability and cost competitiveness of quarried materials. Similarly, Roads of National Significance, intended to improve the safe and efficient transport of people and goods directly and indirectly, presupposes the availability of quarried products. Such products are of both direct and indirect use, in construction and indirectly in the manufacture of concrete and steel building materials.

#### **Renewable Electricity**

The Advisory Group assessed 71 project applications for renewable electricity generation projects, such as wind and solar farms. Six applications were for reconsenting existing facilities rather than new or significantly expanded developments.

Power consumption in New Zealand is projected to rise more than 50% by 2050 as electricity is used increasingly for transport and industrial process heating.<sup>3</sup> Furthermore, the switch in New Zealand's energy usage towards electricity is expected to make a substantial contribution to achieving the nation's emission reduction targets.<sup>4</sup>

We consider that fast-tracking of renewable electricity generation projects could provide benefits under multiple clauses in the Bill including economic development 17(3)(d), climate change mitigation 17(3)(g), resilience 17(3)(h), and more timely and efficient consenting processes 17(2)(b).

The primary basis used by the Advisory Group to recommend and prioritise projects was the expected contribution of each project to new electricity supply. Given the information available in the applications, this basis was considered to be the best yardstick for assessing how projects could advance the objectives in clause 17 of the Bill. As with other sectors, some applications for listing in 2A were instead recommended by the Advisory Group for listing in 2B.







### Number of project applications received by region and type




## Number of project applications recommended for listing by region and type






### Number of projects recommended for 2A status by region and sector




# Number of projects recommended for 2A status by sector and priority ranking
